

Web Evaluation Checklist

Information from a web site should be credible, accurate, and reliable. Use the checklist below to make sure the information you are reading meets these standards.

Authorship

- Authors name appears on the site
- Author provides information about his or her expertise
- Information is clearly stated on the home page
- Date page was created appears on the page

Content

- Home page tells you what the site is about
- Author uses very little opinion words
- Information appears to be accurate
- Information can be easily verified
- Primary source material supports the content
- Site is current and shows last update

Design

- Information easy to read
- Easy to get around the site
- All the links work
- Pictures are helpful to the site
- Going back to the home page is easy
